WHY ARE WE DOING IT?

All studies and statistical surveys, wherever they are carried out, clearly show that apprenticeships are essential to develop sustainable employment (including gaining skills, passing knowledge within the company, tutorship ...).

The benefits of the project will be:

- To better understand barriers faced by SMEs when engaging with apprenticeship schemes
- To identify the SMEs needs to overcome those barriers;
- To support businesses in identifying their potential to offer apprenticeships vacancies;
- To promote the value of apprenticeships in SMEs and their benefits.

HOW WILL WE DO IT?

During the project, many actions will be implemented to improve the situation of apprenticeship in partner territories:

- Survey 240 businesses across Europe
- \bullet Develop and implement a skills brokerage methodology & complete in-company training plans
- Design and deliver direct support services & tools for SMEs engagement in apprenticeships (looking at tutoring support, employment legislation, recruitment support, access to funding, etc.)
- Targeted communication & involvement of employers in an "Apprenticeship Champions" network and campaign.
